
"Sometimes I just channel my mind away from the present and go somewhere in the future where I'm kinda looking back at this time and thinking, 'Wow, cancer really shaped you.

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
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One of my best memories as a filmmaker was returning to Haiti with Huguens Jean (codirector) to screen our film Lift Up in the same neighborhood on Rue Daut where much of the film takes place. They set up a tarp that stretched the whole width of the street and families and kids gathered to see themselves on the big screen, laughing and crying.

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Knowlton is an award-winning documentary filmmaker and photographer born in Paris, France. He became fascinated with the creative world at a young age – spending hours filming his own versions of MTV music videos. After an internship in New York with hip hop video icon, director Little X, he landed a once-in-a-lifetime chance to work alongside Beastie Boys' Adam Yauch as an assistant editor at Oscilloscope Laboratories.

Since then, he's developed and refined his own unique style as a director, cinematographer & editor working primarily in sports & music. From his very first feature length documentary (which followed three cyclists riding across the US to raise awareness for diabetes) to his most recent project, REDEFINED: J.R. Smith (Prime Video), Knowlton's work explores the power of the human spirit and the ties that bind us in this global community. His films and commercial work have been featured in magazines like Communication Arts, AdWeek and have received top prizes from the AICP, Webby and Telly Awards.
